

Homework tasks - Farming theme



This half term, we want to ask you to carry out various activities in your own time. The homework requirements are:

1. You must complete at least one task from each list, so a language task, a numeracy task and a creative task must be completed by the end of the term.
2. You are very welcome to complete more than one, there will be a special prize for each child who manages to complete each language and numeracy task!
3. We recommend that you carry out the tasks every week, as it will be difficult for you to do everything in the last week.
4. You are welcome to borrow resources (paper, printed items, watercolor paints) from the school to help you.
5. Bring the creative tasks to school on Thursday 21st May only, as these tasks are part of our

<p>Create a farming word search.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - There must be between 10 - 15 agricultural words. (Farming words) - Complete the task on A4 paper, online, or in your Homework book. 	<p>Pricing a trip to the Royal Show.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Imagine you are going to the Royal Welsh show, either to show an animal or to go on holiday. - Research the costs of travel, accommodation and entertainment for the trip. - How much will the whole thing cost? 	<p>Cooking and decorating a cake.</p> <p>Theme: 'Farming'</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The cake must be cooked and prepared at home. - Remember to decorate the cake carefully, be unique and creative!
<p>Write a rap or song about farm animals</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Why not write a piece from the animals' perspective, or from the farmer's perspective? - Remember to use the online rhyme book for rhyming help! 	<p>Draw a farm plan from a bird's eye view</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use A4 or A3 paper. Fields with an area of 20cm², 15cm² and 24cm² must be included - Remember to include suitable sheds, and label your diagram. 	<p>2D drawing of an animal</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - You may use a range of materials for your drawing, this is entirely your choice. - You are welcome to use paper of any size, or a special canvas if you like.
<p>Write poem under the title 'Shelter'</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This is part of the Barddas Competition too, where the winner receives a chair and £25. - It must be in Welsh. - Use interesting vocabulary - use a thesaurus. - Create a vivid image of what you're trying to portray for the reader. - 'Shelter' can be about farming or another topic. 	<p>Write 4 maths verbal problems for your friends.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division questions must be written. - Remember to include the answers! 	<p>Photography - Theme: Animals</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 6 photographs must be submitted. Feel free to choose any animal, it doesn't have to be a farm animal. - You are welcome to take black and white or colour photos. - You may print your photos at school if you wish.
